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



ABOUT THE COLLEGE

D.R.M. Science College, formerly known as D.R.M. College, is the mother of all constituent schools and colleges of Bapuji Educational Association. Previously, it was a Government Intermediate college started in 1947 and was run by the Government of Mysore. The BEA took over this college in 1958 and transformed it into First Grade Arts, Commerce and Science College. Being one of the oldest and reputed colleges, it caters to the needs of both rural and urban students. The college is named after its donor, Sri Dharmarathnakara Rajanahalli Maddurayappa, Davangere. The college, owing to its increasing strength, was bifurcated into D.R.M. Science College and A.R.G. Arts and Commerce College in 1973. The college which was formerly affiliated to Kuvempu University, Shivamogga, is now affiliated to the newly started Davangere University. This is an aided college, recognized by UGC under 2f and 12B and also received various UGC grants. The Government of Karnataka took a decision to separate P.U. College from composite Degree Colleges and, accordingly, was further bifurcated into D.R.M. P.U. Science College and D.R.M. Science Degree College in 2001.

The college has been accredited by NAAC in the first cycle with 03 stars on 22 March 2001, in the second cycle with grade B+ on 31 March 2007, third cycle with grade 'B' on 01 May 2015 and fourth cycle with grade B+ on 15 February 2022. The college is proud to have units of NCC, NSS, Rangers and Rovers, and the Youth Red Cross which are supporting in building the personality of the students. In addition, the college has committees like Examination, Research and Development Cell, Career Guidance and Placement Cell, Human Rights/ Human Ethics, Science Forum, Anti-sexual Women Harassment and Anti-ragging Cell, Alumni Association, Sports, Health Care and Yoga, Cultural


The main aim of the programme was to create awareness of the Code of Conduct for students, introducing the faculty members and various departments and also the various committees in the college.

The Department of Physics conducted a Value-Added Course on “**Consumer Electronics**” for II Semester B.Sc. students on **25th March 2025**.



- The students have learned how to get financial support from the government and NGOs.


The Value-Added Course was coordinated by **Dr. Harish Kumar T. S.**, Assistant Professor of Zoology.






